Use your Bible to help you fill in this crossword puzzle.

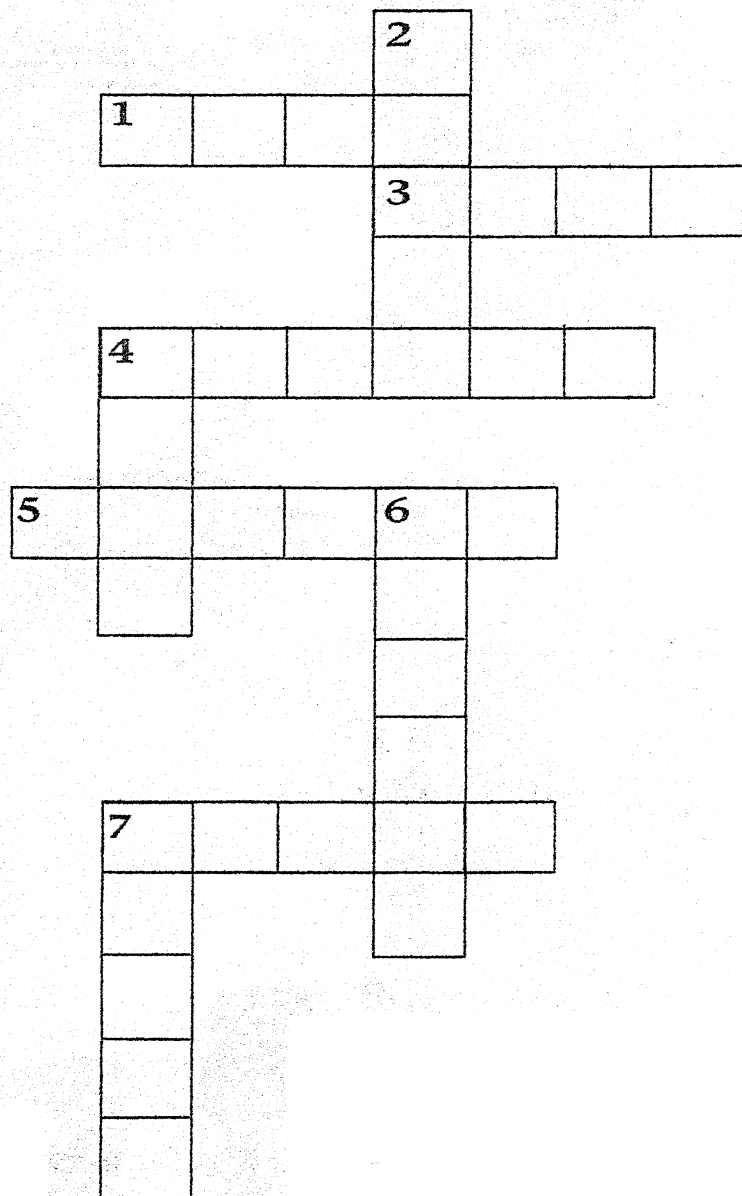
## Clues:

5. This man was sometimes called "the doubter." (Luke 6:15)
7. There were two disciples by this name. One was a son of Zebedee. (Luke 5:10)

2. This man was a Zealot. (Luke 6:15)
4. This man was James' brother. (Luke 5:10)
6. This man was Simon Peter's brother. (Luke 6:14)

Using the 4 books (Gospels – Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) answer as many of the following questions as you can.

1. Which 2 books of the Bible tells about Jesus' birth?
2. What main event is missing from one of the versions of the Christmas story?
3. In what book, chapter and verse does it mention that Jesus is "named"?
4. What book, chapter and verses tell about the wisemen visiting King Herod?
5. When did Joseph leave Egypt (Give book, chapter and verse)?
6. What 2 books (of the Gospels) did not mention the birth of Jesus at all?
7. In what book, chapter and verses do we read the story of Simeon and Anna?
8. Where do Joseph, Mary and baby Jesus meet Simeon and Anna?

9. Why was Joseph afraid to go back to Judea even though King Herod had died? (see Matt 2: 22)
  
10. What was the name of King Herod's son (who became king)?
