C Parable of the Unforgiving Servant	Matthew 18:23-35	___ What we do is more important than what we say.
D Parable of the Workers in the Vineyard	Matthew 20:1-14	___ God's reward for people in heaven is the same whether they began accepting Him as Savior as a little child or very late in life.
E Parable of the Two Sons	Matthew 21:28-32	___ God forgives us no matter what we have done if we are truly sorry
